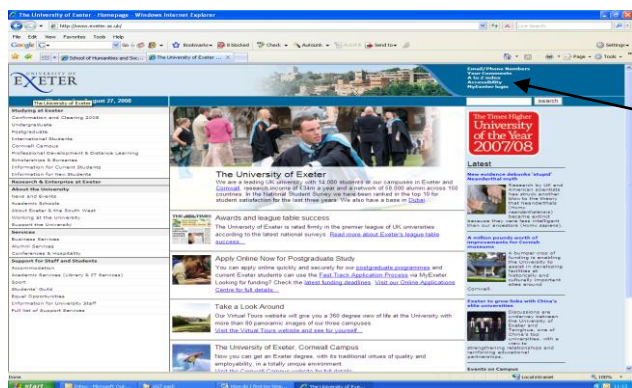


# Your Timetable

- First you need to find your timetable on-line:

## Either

go to <http://admin.exeter.ac.uk/academic/timetable/tt/2010/mytt/index.php> and enter your Exeter log in (eg cba201) and your password to access the information.



## Or use your MyExeter portal:

- click on “MyExeter” on the main University web page near the top right corner of the screen.
- enter your personal Exeter username (eg cba201) and your password.
- Go to the timetable tab.

- Your timetable shows hourly slots Monday - Friday

### Example - part of Monday

	12:00	13.00	14.00
Monday		SOC1099_T1/16 QUB/257 11,14,18	

**SOC1099** shows the code of that module

**QUB/257** shows the building and room number (see over for key to abbreviations)

**11,14,18** shows the week number when it runs (see over for more info on week numbers)

**T1/16** shows the session type:  
**Lecture (L)**  
**Seminar (S)**  
**Tutorial (T)**

*Tutorials have the number of the tutorial group after them eg/02 is group 2. Your timetable may show all the possible tutorial group times, but you will be allocated to or will have to sign up to specific group(s) in your department. Listen to the announcements in your first lectures for each module.*

- **Programme specification** To ensure you are making the right choices within the rules for your programme you need to view the degree programme specification online which lists your core (required) and elective choices.
