Article 12 of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) says that even though the adults make the decisions...

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO BE CONSULTED ON ARRANGEMENTS FOR YOUR CARE IF YOUR PARENTS GO TO MEDIATION OR COURT.



REPRESENTATION

Very few cases end up in court, but if your parents go to court, the professionals will ask you for your opinions and you have the right to be represented in court if necessary.
