To be eligible to apply, you must:

Be a current undergraduate who pays Home/EU fees

AND, be one of the following:

- A British National
- Not a British National but have lived in the UK for 3 or more years before coming to University
- Hold a Refugee Status

AND, at least one of the following must apply to you:

- You receive a bursary from the University of Exeter
- You are a mature student (over 21 on point of entry to University)
- You have a disability
- You have a care leaver
- You are a carer
- You participated in any of the following fair access programmes: STAR, Realising Opportunities, Pathways to Law, Exeter Progression
- You attended a state school or college in a 'Low Participation Neighbourhood'. You can check this by entering your school or college postcode [here](#) and pressing 'check'.
- You lived in a 'Low Participation Neighbourhood', defined by your home postcode. You can check by entering your home postcode [here](#) and pressing 'check'.
