Our Gold Dozi enterprise grew out of The Women's Outreach Project which is run by the Refugee Support Group Devon. The Outreach Project supports women who are seeking asylum in the UK or have joined their refugee husbands here.

Gold Dozi means 'flower sewing' in Farsi and is the traditional embroidery of Afghanistan and Iran, as is the 'white work' creating Islamic designs.

The group is made up of women from the Middle East and different countries of Africa. They enjoy sharing their different skills and meeting with different nationalities.
